- Francis Spence, auxiliary of Military Forces for three years.
- James MacDonald, csc, auxiliary of Hamilton for four years.
- Richard Grecco, auxiliary of London for four years; auxiliary of Toronto for seven years.

- Bernard MacDonald, administrator of the Diocese of Charlottetown, pastor at Rustico and surrounding areas.
- Peter MacIntyre, pastor at Tignish and missions.
